Dear Mr. Henson:

This is to advise you that the Tennessee Real Estate Appraiser Commission has adopted public necessity rules regarding temporary practice that will bring us in compliance with Appraisal Subcommittee guidelines. A permanent set of rules should be in effect prior to the expiration of these rules.

Enclosed is a copy of the rules that became effective August 30, 2001. These rules:

- 1) omit the requirement of a certification history,
- 2) change the fee from \$75 per property to \$150 per assignment,
- 3) change the expiration date from one year to six months with a provision for up to a six-month extension, and
- 4) limits the number of permits to six within a calendar year.
