MS Title 73 chapter 34, Rule 2 provides that each appraisal having four or more signers accepting responsibility for the report shall be awarded credit for an appraisal based on the appropriate hours documented divided by the number of signers.  (2) AQB Criteria requires that experience credit verification form include a description of work performed by the trainee/applican and the scope of the review and supervision of the supervising appraiser. MS Title 73 chapter 34, Rule 11 d.(4) does not require the trainee/applicant to include the scope of the review and supervision of the supervising appraiser.
