This is a response to your letter dated December 20, 1999, in review of the District of Columbia Board of Appraisers.

In your letter there were two concerns that the DC Appraiser Board should respond to.

• [Deletion] license level issued in error.

On February 4, 2000 a certified letter was mailed to Mr. [Deletion] in reference to his license as a Certified General (See letter enclosed)

• Processing of a temporary practice license.

The DC Appraiser Board stands firm in the ASC Policy Statement as to issuing the Temporary Appraiser license within 5 days. Once a completed application package is received the processing center will issue the license. A delay may occur if the applicant doesn't submit the required documents together. The Board looks forward in using the License History Report on the Web site in conjunction with the certification report from the jurisdiction in which the applicant has a license. We are in the process of reviewing the new License System and we will inform you as to how the system can work for us.
