At its June 9, 1999 meeting, the Appraisal Subcommittee ("ASC") approved your May 4th request for supplemental funding to engage a psychometric consultant (Experior Assessments, LLC) to work with the Appraiser Qualifications Board. Attached is a purchase order for your records. The following provisions are incorporated in and made part of this funding commitment.

- Total funding shall not exceed \$205,000;
- This funding is separate from your 1999 Grant and any future grants and should not be comingled with funds from other grants;
- Funding for variable cost items (*e.g.*, printing, mailing, copying, and travel) will be funded at actual costs, not to exceed the amounts specified in Experior's winning proposal;
- Funding for travel costs will be reimbursed at actual costs, not to exceed GSA's authorized hotel and subsistence rates for applicable locations;
- Product deliverables will be those detailed in the Foundation's Request for Proposal and Experior's winning proposal; and
- You should complete monthly reimbursement requests specifically for this funding (*i.e.*, separate from monthly reimbursement requests for other grant monies).
