The Appraisal Subcommittee (ASC) has given careful consideration to Idaho's request for an extension of the effective date for the National Registry fee increase. At its July 21, 2011 meeting, the ASC approved an extension of the effective date to the earlier of the date that Idaho passes the necessary legislation, or July 1, 2012.

In considering Idaho's request, the ASC found that Idaho had experienced extenuating circumstances that thwarted its ability to comply, despite Idaho's good faith efforts to do so. Specifically, the issuance of Bulletin 10-1 *Modification of Annual National Registry Fee* was beyond the deadline for the matter to be added to the State's 2011 legislative docket. In addition, we have been informed that the Office of the Governor of Idaho has determined that it would not use its emergency authority to pass the increase in the National Registry fee.

Please advise the ASC on Idaho's progress to implement the enabling legislation.
