Pursuant to our conversation earlier this week, this letter is written in response to Mr. Yolles letter dated December 7, 1998. As you are aware the Maine Board of Real Estate Appraisers voted to proceed with legislative changes to the current statute which included your recommendations. The legislative document (L.D. 1437) was printed this week (copy enclosed), but the legislative hearing has not been scheduled yet. Assuming that the bill does not sustain significant changes during the session and becomes law, the Board will also need to conduct a rule making process to reflect the changes made to the statute in the board rules. I believe that once these two processes have been completed, the State of Maine will be in compliance with the Subcommittee's Policy Statement 5.
