Thank you for your cooperation and your staff's assistance in our February 27-28, 2007 field review of Utah's real estate appraiser regulatory program. As you may know, during that field review, Appraisal Subcommittee staff identified several concerns regarding the program. One of those concerns is that Utah might have issued certified and licensed appraiser credentials relying on mass appraisal/ad valorem tax appraisal experience without ensuring that the experience met the Appraiser Qualifications Board's minimum criteria.

We will withhold issuance of our field review letter containing our findings until after the May 4-7, 2007 Association of Appraiser Regulatory Officials conference. At that conference there are scheduled discussion sessions regarding mass appraisal/ad valorem tax appraisal experience that might prove helpful in formulating our findings and necessary corrective actions.
